PASTOR'S CORNER

What's the most difficult thing you've ever learned? How long did it take you? Were you tempted to give up? Many of us have spent years learning physical skills or in intellectual pursuits. Practice, discipline, and, yes, failure are all a part of the learning process. Among the most difficult things for Christians to learn is the ability to forgive those who sin against us, to love our enemies, and to obey those in authority over us.

"Although [Jesus] was a son, he learned obedience through what he suffered" (Heb 5:8). There is no human being who doesn't need to be schooled in the art of obedience. None of us is born obedient. Little children don't need to be taught disobedience; that, unfortunately, comes naturally. Jesus didn't have that problem, of course, but even he willingly submitted to learning obedience. We spend our lifetimes learning obedience, as Jesus did. So what Jesus learned he now teaches us from his own experience. As Jesus listened to his heavenly Father, so he helps us listen to and trust our Father in heaven. As we listen to his Word, by the power of his Holy Spirit, Jesus carries us along in a lifetime of learning to become obedient sons and daughters of God.

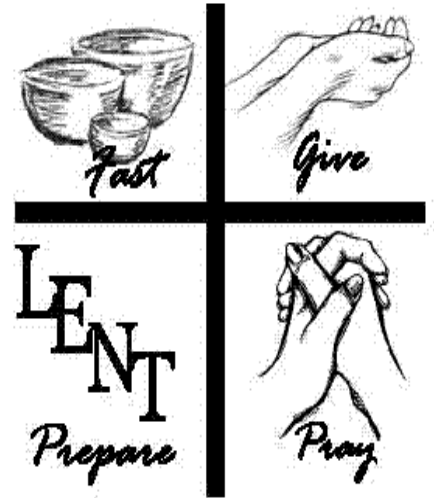
