Little children don't need to be taught disobedience; that, unfortunately, comes naturally. Jesus didn't have that problem, of course, but even he willingly submitted to learning obedience. We spend our lifetimes learning obedience, as Jesus did. So what Jesus learned he now teaches us from his own experience. As Jesus listened to his heavenly Father, so he helps us listen to and trust our Father in heaven. As we listen to his Word, by the power of his Holy Spirit, Jesus carries us along in a lifetime of learning to become obedient sons and daughters of God.


